Philadelphia is one of only five NFL teams with two losses, having now started 8-2 or better in four straight seasons for the first time in franchise history.

.839

The Eagles lead the league in winning percentage (.839, 26-5) since 2024 (including playoffs), winning 24 of their last 27 contests (.889).

150

With the Eagles' victory over Detroit in Week 11, **Howie Roseman** collected his 150th career win as a general manager (including playoffs).

40-2

Under **Nick Sirianni**, the Eagles have produced a 40-2 (.952) record in games when they win the turnover battle (including playoffs).

0-5

In Week 11, the Eagles held the Lions to 0-of-5 on fourth down, becoming the second team in the last 25 years to not allow an opponent conversion on 5+ fourth-down attempts.

56.6%

Philadelphia ranks 1st in the NFL with a 56.6% opponent completion percentage. That includes a league-best 48.0% completion percentage on third and fourth downs.
