



FIRST THINGS FIRST

- The Buccaneers are looking to start 4-0 for the fourth time in team history, and the first time since 2005. Tampa Bay is the first team in the Super Bowl era to record a game-winning score in the final minute of the fourth quarter in each of its first three games of a season.
- Tampa Bay is 4-1 vs. Philadelphia since 2021, including the postseason — the highest win percentage (.800) against the Eagles by any team with multiple games played vs. Philadelphia during that span.
- 19th all-time regular season meeting (series tied 9-9) ... Tampa Bay has won six of the previous seven meetings, including playoffs, dating back to 2015.
- Dating back to the start of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 61 of the last 75 weeks, winning four consecutive NFC South division titles in that span (2021-24).

UNSHAKEABLE BAKE

Despite being down three starting OL, the other two playing out of position, and Mike Evans leaving due to injury, **Baker Mayfield** rallied the Buccaneers for their third consecutive game-winning drive. Whether it's through the air or with his legs, Mayfield has willed Tampa Bay to a 3-0 start to the 2025 season.

NEVER SAY DIE: THE BUCCANEERS OFFENSE IS GETTING IT DONE WHEN IT MATTERS MOST



The Buccaneers are the first team in the Super Bowl era to have a game-winning score in the final minute of the fourth quarter in three consecutive games to begin the season, and only the third team ever to do so at any point in a season (2017 Pittsburgh Steelers, 1994 New York Giants).

TURNOVER FREE FOOTBALL

Under first-year offensive coordinator **Josh Grizzard**, Tampa Bay has opened with three consecutive turnover-free games. It marked the fifth time in team history in which the Buccaneers have gone three consecutive games without turning the ball over, and the first-such occurrence since 2022 (Weeks 5-7).

All three teams who have yet to commit a turnover in 2025 have begun the season with a 3-0 record (Tampa Bay, Buffalo, Indianapolis).

OFFENSIVE NOTES



In his NFL debut **Emeka Egbuka** tallied four receptions for 67 yards and a pair of receiving touchdowns, including the go-ahead score with just 59 seconds remaining in regulation. He later tied the NFL record for most receiving touchdowns through two career games (three).

Through the first three weeks of the season, **Egbuka** leads the Buccaneers in both receiving yards (181) and receiving touchdowns (three), while tying for the team lead in receptions (14).

Baker Mayfield is 1-of- 3 quarterbacks this season with at least five passing touchdowns and zero interceptions this season, joining the previous two AP NFL MVP winners, Josh Allen and Lamar Jackson.

Mayfield currently ranks tied for third in the NFL in passing touchdowns (six) and continues to lead the league in that category since his arrival in 2023 (75).

BULLISH ON BUCKY



Bucky Irving scored his first receiving touchdown in Week 1 at Atlanta, while tallying the ninth total touchdown from scrimmage of his career. He then added 121 scrimmage yards (71 rushing, 50 receiving) in Week 2 at Houston and another 99 in Week 3 vs. the New York Jets (66 rushing, 33 receiving).

Despite being the No. 125 overall pick in the 2024 class, **Irving** leads his draft class in scrimmage yards (1,779), rushing yards (1,296) and rushing touchdowns (eight).

Irving has proven himself to be one of the most elusive backs in the league since entering in 2024, and per NextGen Stats, he ranks fourth in missed tackles forced (94), first in missed tackles forced percentage (35.5% - min. 200 carries) and second in total yards gained following forced missed tackles (519) during that span.

GET HIS GOLD JACKET READY

A season ago, **Mike Evans** tied Pro Football Hall of Famer Jerry Rice for the most consecutive 1,000-yard receiving seasons in NFL history (11) and surpassed Randy Moss (10) for the second-most total 1,000-yard seasons in league history behind only Rice (14).

Since the start of last season, the Buccaneers are 13-4 with **Evans** active (0-3 without) and are 13-2 in games in which Evans has five-plus targets.

GETTING INTO THE BACKFIELD

The Buccaneers rank second in the NFL in quarterback pressures this season (58), second in tackles for loss (21), tied for sixth in quarterback hits (19) and tied for 10th in sacks (8.0).

Tampa Bay is 1-of-2 teams this season with at least 10 pressures and five-or-more tackles for loss in all three games so far this season, joining the Pittsburgh Steelers.



Lavonte David led Tampa Bay with 11 tackles (one for loss), two quarterback hits and 1.0 sack in Week 3. David's sack increased his season total to a team-high 1.5 and his career total to 40.5. In doing so, David became the **fourth player in NFL history to record at least 40.0 career sacks, 30 forced fumbles and 10 interceptions**, joining Pro Football Hall of Famer Julius Peppers, Mo Lewis and Greg Lloyd.

On the season, **David** leads the team in sacks (1.5) and ranks tied for second in quarterback hits (three), third in tackles (22) and tied for third in tackles for loss (two).

At age 34, **Lavonte David** was the lone player last season with 100+ tackles, 5.0+ sacks and three-or-more forced fumbles. Over the past 10 seasons, only four players have recorded these numbers in a single season: David (2024), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2023), Shaquille Leonard (2018) and Thomas Davis Sr. (2015).

Per the Associated Press, since 1991, David became just the eighth player to record 40+ sacks and 30+ takeaways, including playoffs, joining Karlos Dansby, Ray Lewis, London Fletcher, Julius Peppers, Junior Seau, Jason Taylor and Brian Urlacher. Five of the other seven players in this group are members of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

- Dating back to the start of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 61 of the last 75 weeks, winning four consecutive NFC South division titles in that span (2021-24).




