PHILADELPHIA EAGLES at BUFFALO BILLS

EAGLES DEFEAT BILLS, 13-12, TO IMPROVE TO 11-5

- Philadelphia improved to 11-5 (.688) with today's 13-12 victory at Buffalo. The Eagles have won 11+ games in four straight seasons – the 2nd-longest streak in team history (five, 2000-04).
- According to *Elias Sports*, **Nick Sirianni** tied **Don Shula** (65, 1970-74 Dolphins) for the 3rd-most wins by a head coach during their first five seasons with a team (including playoffs), behind **George Seifert** (68, 1989-93 49ers) and **Tony Dungy** (67, 2002-06 Colts) in that category.
 - Among that group, only Sirianni (4-11-1 Eagles in 2020) and Shula (3-10-1 Dolphins in 1969) took over teams that won four-or-fewer games the year before being hired.
- **Nick Sirianni** (65) also surpassed **Greasy Neale** (64, 1941-50) for the 2nd-most wins by a head coach in franchise history (including playoffs), trailing only **Andy Reid** (140, 1999-2012).
 - Including playoffs, Philadelphia has logged the best winning percentage (.747, 56-19) in the NFL dating back to 2022, including a 29-8 (.784) mark since the start of 2024.
 - The Eagles lead the league in road winning percentage (.667, 30-15) since 2021 (including playoffs). Philadelphia owns an 11-4 (.733) record over its last 15 away games.
 - The Eagles lead the NFC and rank T-2nd in the NFL in interconference winning percentage (.760, 19-6) since 2021, trailing only Kansas City (.800, 20-5). Including playoffs, Philadelphia is 12-2 (.857) over its last 14 games vs. AFC opponents.

POST-GAME NOTES

- The Eagles jumped out to a 7-0 lead with :35 seconds remaining in the first quarter after a 1-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to **Dallas Goedert** capped off a 7-play, 45-yard (3:25) drive. The drive was set up by a Strip Sack from **Jaelan Phillips** on Bills QB **Josh Allen** that was recovered by **Jihaad Campbell** at the BUF 45.
 - Goedert has set the Eagles TE record for single-season receiving TDs (11), also becoming the first Eagle to total 11+ receiving TDs in a season since 2022.
 - Goedert is tied for the 5th-most receiving TDs (11) in team history, behind **Terrell Owens** in 2004 (14), **Mike Quick** in 1983 (13) and **Tommy McDonald** in 1960 (13) and 1961 (13).
 - **Jaelan Phillips** recorded his first FF since 12/17/22 at Buf.
 - Campbell recorded his second career takeaway with the FR (first career FR), marking his first since 9/28/25 at TB (INT).

- Philadelphia extended the lead to 10-0 on a 47-yard FG by **Jake Elliott**, completing a 13-play, 48-yard (5:54) drive. The drive was sparked by conversions of third-and-4 and third-and-10 on passes from **Jalen Hurts** to **DeVonta Smith** and **A.J. Brown**.
- With a 28-yard FG by **Jake Elliott**, the Eagles increased their lead to 13-0, closing out a 10-play, 61-yard (2:41) drive. With the make, Elliott reached 1,000 career points, becoming just the second player in franchise history to accomplish the feat, joining **David Akers** (1,323, 1999-2010).
 - During the drive, **A.J. Brown** produced his franchise-record fourth consecutive season with 1,000+ receiving yards on an 8-yard catch from **Jalen Hurts**. Brown is one of four NFL players with 1,000+ receiving yards every year since 2022, joining **Ja'Marr Chase**, **CeeDee Lamb** and **Amon-Ra St. Brown**.
 - Brown has reached 1,000+ receiving yards in six of his seven NFL seasons.
- **Jalen Carter** blocked an extra point attempt by Bills K **Michael Badgley** to keep the game 13-6 in the fourth quarter.

MORE FROM THE GAME

- With the first quarter forced and recovered fumble, the Eagles' streak of eight consecutive games forcing a turnover (Weeks 10-17) is tied with Chicago for the longest active streak in the NFL. It is the club's longest streak since 2022 (11, Weeks 1-12).
- Philadelphia held Buffalo to 0 points in the first half, marking the first time the Bills have been shut out in the first half in Buffalo since 10/15/23 vs. NYG. Since **Josh Allen** became the Bills full-time starter in 2019, the Bills have only been shut out three times in the first half at home (12/29/19 vs. NYJ, 10/15/23 vs. NYG, 12/28/25 vs. Phi).
- Since Week 13, Philadelphia leads the NFL with 20.0 sacks.
 - The Eagles defense brought down Bills QB **Josh Allen** three times in the first half, marking the first time this season that Allen has been sacked 3.0+ times in a first half.
- **Braden Mann** totaled 388 yards on 7 punts (55.4 avg.), including 2 punts of 60+ yards (65 and 62) and 2 punts inside the 20-yard line, pinning the Bills at the BUF 10 and BUF 17.
