The Dallas Cowboys and Philadelphia Eagles are set for their 32nd primetime meeting, the most primetime matchups between two teams in NFL history.

Dak Prescott is 33-8 against the NFC East since he entered the NFL in 2016. Prescott's 33 wins against divisional foes rank second among NFL quarterbacks since 2016, trailing only Patrick Mahomes (35).

Dallas is 41-23-1 (.638) all-time in season openers, the highest winning percentage among NFL teams for season openers.

Since 2022, CeeDee Lamb and George Pickens have combined for 7,143 receiving yards, the second-most among NFL wide receiver duos over the past three seasons, trailing only Miami's Tyreek Hill and Jaylen Waddle.



★ WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN WEEK 1 ★

DAK PRESCOTT



- * Dak Prescott set the club record for passing yards in a season opener when he threw for 405 yards in a win over the N.Y. Giants in 2019.
- Prescott (2,780) is 50 completions away from passing Tony Romo (2,829) for second in franchise history on the all-time completions list.
- * Entering his 10th year in the NFL, Prescott has a 33-8 career record against the NFC East, the second-most wins against his division among NFL quarterbacks. Only Patrick Mahomes, with 35 wins, has more victories against his division than Prescott.

KAVONTAE TURPIN



- KaVontae Turpin averaged 33.5 yards-per-kickoff return in 2024, highest in the NFL and a single-season franchise record. Turpin's 33.5 kickoff return average was also the second-highest since the NFL merger, trailing only Jim Duncan (35.4 in 1970).
- Turpin was the only player in the NFL to have a punt return and kickoff return for a touchdown in 2024. He also became the first player in franchise history with a punt return, kick return and receiving touchdown in a season.

BRANDON AUBREY



- Brandon Aubrey made 40 field goals in 2024, setting the franchise record for the most field goals made in a season. Aubrey's 76 career field goals are the most in a player's first two seasons in NFL history.
- * Aubrey was lights out from long distance in 2024. He set the NFL record for the most 50-yard field goals made in a season with 14. Combined with his 10 makes from 50-or-more yards in 2023, Aubrey became the first player in NFL history with at least 10 made field goals from 50-plus yards in multiple seasons.
- * In the 2024 season opener at Cleveland, Aubrey made a 57-yard field goal, the longest in a season opener in franchise history.

DARON BLAND

 DaRon Bland needs one interception returned for a touchdown to become the first player in NFL history to record six pick-sixes in the first four seasons of a career.

CEEDEE LAMB



- CeeDee Lamb is entering his sixth season and has 496 career receptions, the second-most in a player's first five seasons in NFL history, behind only Michael Thomas (510).
- * With a 100-yard receiving game, Lamb will tie Bob Hayes (22 games) for the third-most 100-yard games in franchise history.
- * Lamb has recorded 1,000 receiving yards in four consecutive seasons and is the first player in franchise history with at least 1,000 receiving yards in four of his first five seasons.

DALLAS COWBOYS



- * This week's game marks the NFL's 24th annual Kickoff Game. Dallas has played twice in the NFL Kickoff Game. In 2012 the Cowboys defeated the N.Y. Giants 24-17 and most recently in 2021, Dallas took on Tom Brady and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, falling 29-31 at Raymond James Stadium.
- * There have been four matchups between the Dallas Cowboys and Philadelphia Eagles on opening weekend (1970, 1972, 1976 and 2000). Dallas won three of the four meetings, with its lone loss coming in 2000.
- * A win at Philadelphia on Thursday night would mark the third consecutive season that Dallas won its season opener. The last time the Cowboys won three straight season openers was from 2007-09.
- * With a win on Thursday, Head Coach Brian Schottenheimer would be the first Cowboys head coach to win his first game at the helm since Wade Phillips in 2007. Schottenheimer would also become the fourth head coach to win his first game as Cowboys head coach, joining Barry Switzer, Chan Gailey and Wade Phillips.

★ SEASON OPENERS

The Dallas Cowboys enter their 66th season with the highest opening-day win percentage (.638) in the NFL. Dallas' 41 opening-day wins are tied for fifth all-time in NFL history.

Dallas won 17 consecutive season-opening games from

1965-81, the longest opening-day win streak in league history.
The Cowboys opened the 2024 campaign with a 33-17 victory at Cleveland.

This year Dallas will hit the road to face the Philadelphia Eagles in the 2025 NFL Kickoff Game on NBC's Sunday Night Football broadcast. The Cowboys and Eagles have opened the season against each other four times, with Dallas holding a 3-1 record.

DAL VS. PHI - OPENING DAY

In 65 years of Cowboys football, there have been four matchups between the Dallas Cowboys and Philadelphia Eagles on opening weekend. Dallas has won three of the four contests. Three of the four games were played in Dallas, with the lone Week 1 meeting in Philadelphia coming in 1970.

The first ever season opening contest between Dallas and Philadelphia occurred in 1970, resulting in a Cowboys 17-7 victory. Their last opening weekend matchup was in 2000, a 14-41 loss for Dallas.

BEAST OF THE EAST ★

Dak Prescott has faced a division opponent on opening day four times in his career, sporting a 3-1 record, with his only loss in his NFL debut against the N.Y. Giants in 2016.

Since entering the league in 2016, Prescott holds a 96.8 passer rating in season openers when playing division rivals, third among active quarterbacks:

★ DAL VS. PHI SERIES HISTORY

Dallas and Philadelphia have squared off 132 times, including postseason, with the Cowboys holding a 74-58 edge in one of the NFL's most high-profile rivalries. There have been four playoff games - one Wild Card Game (2009), two Divisional Playoff Games (1992 and 1995) and an NFC Championship Game (1980). Dallas holds a 3-1 postseason record against the Eagles. Below is a brief look at the last 20 games of the series:

★ INSIDE THE SERIES HISTORY ★

The rivalry between the Dallas Cowboys and Philadelphia Eagles has been around since 1960. The two teams have faced each other twice per season as part of the NFC East since 1970.

In the 132 games of the series there has been:

- * 60 games decided by two-or-more touchdowns
- 50 games decided by a touchdown-or-less
- * An 11-game winning streak by Dallas (1967-72)
- * A 49-point win by Dallas biggest Cowboys win (10/9/66)
- * A 38-point loss by Dallas biggest Cowboys loss (12/28/06)
- * Four playoff games one Wild Card (2009), two Divisional (1992, 1995) and one NFC Championship Game (1980)
- * Three playoff wins by Dallas the Wild Card game and both Divisional Games
- Four overtime games series split at 2-2
- * 12 Monday night games and 15 Sunday night games
- * A 43-25 Cowboys record when playing in Dallas
- * A 31-33 Cowboys record when playing in Philadelphia

The Dallas Cowboys open the season in primetime on NBC's Sunday Night Football broadcast against the defending Super Bowl champion Philadelphia Eagles on Thursday night. Cowboys were 3-3 in primetime games in 2024 and are tied for a league-high six primetime bouts in 2025. Since 2022, Dallas is 11-6 in primetime games, tied for the third-most primetime wins over the last three seasons:

★ NFL KICKOFF GAME ★

The Dallas Cowboys open the NFL season in primetime on NBC's Sunday Night Football broadcast against the defending Super Bowl champion Philadelphia Eagles on Thursday night.

This week's matchup marks the NFL's 24th annual Kickoff Game. Started in 2002, the NFL has hosted its annual Kickoff Game to mark the official start of the regular season. In 23 Kickoff games, the defending Super Bowl champions have played 20 times and have a 15-5 record in the NFL's opener.

AT&T Stadium, home of the Dallas Cowboys, completed its most significant renovation since opening in 2009. The renovation was a \$295 million upgrade that included:

- Refreshing the interior premium clubs and suites
- Upgrading the world's largest center-hung HDTV video board to 4K technology
- Creating additional permanent concession and bar locations
- Creating additional wellness spaces within the main clubs and upper concourse
- Updating finishes and enhancing technology displays around the venue
- Re-imagined suite design and finishes including updated technology applications
- Re-designing and creating an all-new look and feel of suite level corridors

These updates are designed not only to elevate the fan experience but also to prepare the venue for its role in the 2026 FIFA World Cup, where it will host a tournament-high nine matches, including a semi-final.
