COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Started 37 of 39 career games at Boston College (2021-24) ... Earned All-ACC first-team accolades as a redshirt junior in 2024 after posting a team-best 83.1 pass-block grade and 76.8 offensive grade via *Pro Football Focus*
- In 2023, started all 13 games at center, anchoring an offensive line that paved the way for 198.8 rushing yards per game, ranking 13th-best in the FBS and 2nd in the ACC ... Aided the Golden Eagles in increasing the team’s win total by four from the previous season
