- ▶ Prepped at Greater Atlanta Christian (GA), where he was graded by 247Sports as a four-star prospect, the No. 74-ranked player nationally, the No. 6 tackle and the No. 8 player in the state of Georgia ... Helped lead the Spartans to four regional championships ... Was a three-sport athlete who also competed in basketball and track and field, earning a state championship title in discus in 2018

- Saw action in 46 contests at Stanford (2020-22) and Michigan (2023-24), starting 11 games at LT and 20 at RT ... In 2024, earned All-Big Ten honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and media
- ▶ In 2023, appeared in 13 contests (five starts) for the CFP National Championship-winning Michigan Wolverines team ... Aided **Blake Corum** in setting a program single-season TD rushing record (27), a top-10 Heisman Trophy finish and earning first-team All-American honors
- Collected three varsity letters at Stanford (2020-22) after appearing in 23 games (16 starts) at RT ... In 2022, started all seven games, blocking for Tanner McKee when his 264 completions tied for the 5th-most single-season completions in Cardinal history
