BIRDSEED

- ▶ In October of 2021, launched "Cal's Kids," an initiative to raise \$94,000 for UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh ... The dollar total was inspired by his No.94 jersey number, but the effort ultimately raised nearly \$115,000
- ▶ His brother, Graham Adomitis, was a first-team All-Ivy League tight end at Princeton and a Tiger's team captain
- ▶ Served as Pitt's president of the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) during his undergraduate studies

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Entered the NFL as a UDFA with Cincinnati and played in 49 contests, including three postseason games when the Bengals made an appearance in Super Bowl LVI

- ▶ Saw action in 17 contests, and totaled 140 snaps on special teams

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Pittsburgh, where he finished his career as the most accomplished long snapper in Pitt history ... Selected a first team All-American at that position by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA), the only one of the five NCAA-recognized All-American selectors that chooses a long snapper
- ▶ Handled both long and short snapping for the Panthers in every game from 2017-21, a streak of 64 consecutive contests
- ▶ Recipient of the Blue-Gold Award, presented to the senior student athletes who best academic scholarship, athletic achievement, leadership qualities and citizenship; the winners of the award have their names engraved on the Varsity Walk on Pitt's campus
