- ▶ Earned a nomination as the Dolphins' Walter Payton Man of the Year candidate in 2022 ... The award is considered the highest honor in the NFL and highlights players who have positively impacted the community and shown excellence on the field
- ▶ During his time in Miami, founded the Jaelan Phillips Foundation, which strives to empower youth to achieve greatness through music education programs as well as sports programs ... The foundation focuses on music education, athletic camps and community partnerships ... Phillips also partnered with Green Tea Studios in Santa Monica to provide youth with meaningful music education experience
- ▶ Has been heavily involved with Lotus House in Miami ... The homeless shelter is the largest women's homeless shelter in the United States, aiming to provide a safe haven for women, youth and children ... Phillips routinely would stop in to play games, talk about life and do arts and crafts during his time with the Dolphins

CAREER HIGHLIGHTSO

- ▶ Originally selected by Miami in the 1st Round (18th overall) of the 2021 NFL Draft ... Spent first five seasons of career with the Dolphins, playing in 55 contests (38 starts) and notched 177 tackles (105 solo), 61 QB hits, 28 TFLs, 26.0 sacks, 4 FRs and 1 FF

2025 SEASON - DOLPHINS & EAGLES

- ▶ Appeared in the first nine contests (nine starts) with Miami, totaling 25 tackles (15 solo), 3.0 sacks, 3 TFLs, 1 FR and 29 QB pressures before being traded to Philadelphia in Week 10

2024 SEASON - DOLPHINS

- ▶ Played in four games (three starts) before having his season cut short due to injury ... Recorded 6 tackles (2 solo) and 1.0 sack

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at UCLA (2017-18), before concluding his career at Miami (2020) ... Across the two schools, appeared in 21 games and recorded 86 tackles, 23.5 TFLs and 12.0 sacks ... In 2020, earned second-team All-America honors from *Associated Press* and second-team All-ACC honors from the Hurricanes after leading the team in both TFLs (15.5) and sacks (8.5) ... Also was a semifinalist for the Bednarik Award (nation's best defensive player) in 2020
