EAGLES DEFEAT TITANS, 24-20, TO IMPROVE TO 2-0

- Philadelphia has improved to 2-0 for the fourth time under **Nick Sirianni** (also 2022, 2023 and 2025).
 - Sirianni's four 2-0 starts are the most by a head coach in franchise history.
- The Eagles lead the NFL with a .705 (31-13) road winning percentage since the 2021 season.
 - According to *Elias Sports*, **Nick Sirianni** is just the fourth head coach in NFL history to capture the first six road openers of their career, joining **Sean McVay** (seven, 2017-23), **George Allen**^{HOF} (seven, 1966-72) and **Mike McCarthy** (six, 2006-11) in that category.
 - **Jalen Hurts** and **Roger Staubach**^{HOF} (eight, 1970-79) are the only NFL QBs to start their career with six consecutive wins in road openers – per *Elias Sports*.
 - Overall, Hurts is just the fifth QB in NFL history to win six straight road openers, along with **Dan Fouts**^{HOF} (nine, 1976-85), **Roger Staubach**^{HOF} (eight, 1970-79), **Bart Starr**^{HOF} (seven, 1961-68) and **Fran Tarkenton**^{HOF} (seven, 1971-77).
- Philadelphia owns the top interconference winning percentage (.857, 18-3) in the NFL since 2022.
 - During that stretch, the Eagles are 9-2 (.818) in road games vs. AFC opponents.
- **Nick Sirianni** is now one of only five head coaches in NFL history with a .700+ career winning percentage (.701, 61-26), joining **Guy Chamberlin**^{HOF} (.784, 1922-27), **John Madden**^{HOF} (.759, 1969-78), **Vince Lombardi**^{HOF} (.738, 1959-67 and '69) and **George Allen**^{HOF} (.712, 1966-77) (min. 50 games).

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- **Tank Bigsby** tied the game, 7-7, in the second quarter with a 2-yard rushing TD (Bigsby's 3rd rushing TD since joining the Eagles during the 2025 season), completing an 11-play, 65-yard possession.
- Philadelphia claimed a 14-7 lead at the end of the first half with a 22-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to **DeVonta Smith** on second-and-19. Smith caught 2 passes for 40 yards during the 81-yard drive.
 - **Dontayvion Wicks** played a critical role in keeping the series alive with a pair of clutch receptions on fourth-and-2 from the TEN 46 (5 yards) and third-and-12 from the TEN 28 (15 yards).
- **Jake Elliott** gave the Eagles a 17-10 advantage in the third quarter with a 58-yard FG. The kick tied for the 4th-longest FG of Elliott's career and was his longest since 9/14/25 at Kansas City (also 58 yards).
 - Elliott has recorded the most 50+ yard FGs (34) in Eagles history (including playoffs).
- **Darius Cooper** notched his first career TD to recapture a 24-20 lead in the fourth quarter with a 3-yard pass from **Jalen Hurts**, culminating a 9-play, 65-yard possession.
 - The score was set up by a 20-yard reception by **Dontayvion Wicks** on 3rd-and-6 from the PHI 39 and a 19-yard catch by **DeVonta Smith** on 3rd-and-6 from the TEN 22.

MORE FROM THE GAME

- During the game, **Jalen Hurts** eclipsed **Carson Wentz** (1,562; 2016-20) for the 4th-most career completions in Eagles history (1,582).
- Philadelphia held Tennessee to 291 total yards, marking the first time since 1995 that the Eagles held their opponents under 300 total yards in each of the first two games (295 total yards in Week 1 vs. Washington).
 - The Eagles also held the Titans' passing output to only 183 yards, keeping their opponents under 200 passing yards in each of the first two games for the first time since 2021 (164 passing yards in Week 1 vs. Washington).
